PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

Guidelines & Eligibility

1. Students attending an LAUSD Secondary School (grades 6-12) within the 31st District PTSA area (San Fernando Valley – Sunland – Tujunga).
2. The scholarship must be used between June 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.
3. Students may only receive the Darlene Panfill Music Scholarship twice.
4. **No school may submit the names of more than FIVE applicants in any one category. No more than TWENTY applications may be submitted per school.**
5. Students are judged on evidence shown through their dedication to musical arts and desire to furthering their musical instruction.
6. **Eligibility is NOT restricted to students who are currently enrolled in music classes.**
7. No money is to be paid directly to the winners of the scholarship. Private teachers are paid directly by the 31st District PTSA Office.
8. **Students who want to audition in two different categories must fill out separate applications for each category. Forms may be duplicated.**
9. Students should be dressed appropriately for auditions and concert.

Application:

1. PTSA Music Scholarship Application Form – Applicants must complete the application form and it must be approved and signed by a parent/guardian. (Please keep a copy for your records)
2. Applications are to be sent to the Music Scholarship Committee at the 31st District PTSA Office and **RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 4:00 p.m. on February 8, 2019**. It must be sent via US Mail, hand delivered or emailed to lrosspta@hotmail.com, and must be accompanied by the following:
 - a. Proof of attendance to an LAUSD Secondary School (grades 6-12) within the 31st District PTSA area (principal, assistant principal or music teacher's signature on application)
 - b. If applying via us mail or hand delivering, **a self-addressed stamped envelope** must be provided with your application.
3. Application also available online at www.31stdistpts.org. Deadlines stated above still apply.

Auditions:

1. **Auditions will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2019.** Information and directions to the audition will be sent to the applicants prior to this date, either by email or USPS, depending how application was submitted. If any applicant does not receive their audition time prior to February 23, 2019 or if you are unable to make your appointed time please contact Linda Ross at 818 800-0846 by phone or text. An audition time change may be requested, however, there is NO guarantee that the request will be fulfilled.
2. Applicants must arrive at their audition at least twenty minutes prior to their assigned time.
3. **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE YOUR OWN ACCOMPANIST AND INSTRUMENTS.** A piano will be available **only** in the piano category. An electronic piano will be provided for warm-up and concert.
4. You must provide at least two copies of the music that you intend to perform to the judges at your audition.
5. Each applicant will be given a maximum of five minutes to perform.
6. **ANY APPLICANT WHO FAILS TO ATTEND THEIR DESIGNATED AUDITION TIME WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION TO LINDA ROSS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE FOLLOWING YEAR.**
7. **The judge's decisions are final. There are NO appeals.**
